Appendix: EventPay user agreement

#### "EventPay" User Agreement

#### Article 1 (Purpose)

These terms and conditions govern the use of Event Pay (the "Service") operated by METAPPAYMENT CORPORATION (the "Company") for the reservation and sale of events for permanent or non-permanent events and other services (the "Events, etc.") by customers of the Company.

<u>Article 2</u> (Responsible Entity for Events, etc.)

- (1) The Company shall accept applications for and conduct sales of Events on behalf of the organizer of the Event, etc. or a third party to whom the organizer has entrusted the management, operation, etc. of the Event, etc. (hereinafter referred to as the "Organizer, etc."). 2.
- (2) The Company shall not be liable for any delay or non-performance of the Event, the content of the Event, or any other matters related to the Event itself. Please contact the organizer, etc., regarding these matters. 3.
- (3)There may be restrictions on the number of events sold or the number of people to whom events can be sold, as specified by the organizer. In the event that there are too many applicants, events may be sold by lottery. We do not guarantee that an event will be sold to all applicants who wish to purchase an event.

<u>Article 3</u> (Preparation of Usage Environment)

- (1)You shall prepare at your own responsibility and expense the telecommunication equipment, software, Internet connection contract, etc. necessary for you to use the Service. The Company shall not bear any communication fees, connection fees, etc. related to your use of the Service. 2.
- (2) The Customer acknowledges in advance that the Service may not be available depending on the model of the mobile terminal or other usage environment. (3) The Customer agrees to use the Service at its own risk and expense.

You shall set up your e-mail environment so that you can always receive e-mails from the Company related to the Service.

Article 4 (Terms of Use)

(1) Customers using the Service shall confirm and agree to the terms of this Agreement and shall use the Service in accordance with the procedures prescribed by the Company. 2.

If you are a minor, you shall obtain the prior consent of a legal representative, such as a person with parental authority, to enter into these Terms of Use and use the Service.

Article 5 (Usage Agreement)

- 1. the customer shall make an application based on the "Individual Regulations Event Sales" separately stipulated, and upon our acceptance of such application, a contract of use based on these Terms of Use shall be formed between the customer and us.
- 2. The Company may not approve your application if any of the following applies to you.
- (i) If you have ever had a contract with the organizer or the Company canceled or otherwise violated in the past.
- (ii) If there is any falsehood, misdescription, or omission in the contents of the application
- (iii) If you are a minor and have not obtained the consent of a legal representative such as a person with parental authority
- (iv) If the credit card company, financial institution, etc. suspends the use of the means of payment designated by the customer

(v) If we deem it inappropriate to enter into a contract of use for any other reasonable reason. 3.If a minor uses the Service, his/her legal representative shall be jointly and severally liable with the customer for the customer's use of the Service.

#### Article 6 (Notices)

- (1) Notification of changes to these Terms and Conditions and other notifications from the Company to you shall be made by e-mail, general posting on the EventPay website, or by any other method deemed appropriate by the Company. 2.
- (2) If the notification in the preceding paragraph is made by e-mail, the notification to you shall be deemed to have been completed when it is sent to the e-mail address you have provided to the Company in advance.

### <u>Article 7</u> (Suspension or Cancellation of Service)

- (1)the Company may, without prior notice to the customer, immediately suspend or cancel the customer's use of the service and terminate the contract of use if any of the following items applies to the customer
- (i) In the event that a customer commits an act that violates Article 15 and falls under the prohibited items.
- (ii) In the event of delay or failure to fulfill payment obligations such as fees, etc.
- (iii) In the event that payment is not made by wire transfer or other payment procedures despite the conclusion of a purchase contract
- (iv) When the operation of this service is interfered with in any way
- (v) If the credit card company, collection agency, financial institution, etc. suspends the use of the payment method designated by the customer
- (vi) When it is recognized that there was fraud at the time of the conclusion of the contract for use of the Service
- (vii) If you use the Service for commercial purposes
- (viii) If you violate these Terms of Use
- (ix) In any other case that the Company deems inappropriate based on reasonable grounds. 2.
- (2) you shall be liable to compensate the Company or any other third party for any damages incurred by the Company or any other third party as a result of any act that falls under any of the items of the preceding paragraph.

### Article 8 (Formation, Change, and Cancellation of Event Reservations)

- 1. a reservation for participation in the Service shall be established when the customer registers an application on the application acceptance site and the "application number" is displayed on the customer's terminal device (personal computer, tablet, smart phone, cell phone, etc.).
- 2.Once a reservation has been made in accordance with the preceding paragraph, the reservation cannot be changed or cancelled on the Service for any reason. The customer shall contact the organizer directly to change or cancel the reservation.

#### Article 9 (Payment of Price)

- 1. you shall select one of the methods designated by us and pay for the participation right (hereinafter referred to as the "Payment")
- 2. If you choose "payment at a convenience store," you shall pay the Payment within the prescribed time limit. If the payment is not made within the prescribed time limit, the reservation for such Participation shall be automatically cancelled, and the Customer shall not be entitled to make any objection thereto.

- 3.If you choose "Credit Card Payment," you shall register your credit card information in accordance with the prescribed procedure using a valid credit card held in your name, and pay for the Participation by automatic payment on the date designated by the Company.
- 4.If you select "Pay-easy Payment", you shall pay the payment through Pay-easy payment at an Internet banking site, mobile banking site, or ATM based on the "Payment Number" issued to you.
- 5. We may set restrictions on the method of payment. In addition, the Company may add or change various fees and payment methods by giving prior notice to the customer in a manner the Company deems appropriate.

Article 10 (Refusal of Reservation Sales, etc.)

- 1. In the event that a customer falls under any of the following items, the Company may refuse to accept event reservations or sales, and may suspend or cancel the customer's use of the service.
- (i) When a customer makes a false declaration or fails to make a required declaration with respect to any matter specified by the Company
- (ii) In the event that the customer acts in such a manner as to cause inconvenience to other customers or third parties in making reservations for participation rights, etc.
- (iii) In the event that the customer fails to follow the prescribed procedures within the prescribed time limit
- (iv) the Participant fails to follow the prescribed purchase procedures; or
- (v) In the event of any other acts in violation of these Terms and Conditions.
- 2. If the Company incurs any damage in the preceding paragraph, the Company may demand compensation from the relevant customer.

Article 11 (Replacement, Change, and Cooling-off)

Once a reservation for participation rights has been made, the reservation may not be changed, cancelled, or replaced for any reason whatsoever. The cooling-off provision shall not apply to the sale of participation rights reserved through the Service.

Article 12 (Re-issuance)

The Company shall not reissue tickets issued at the time of reservation sales under any circumstances (loss, theft, damage, etc.).

Article 13 (Refund)

- 1. The organizer, etc. shall bear all responsibility (including responsibility for notification) for any change in content, cancellation, or postponement of an event, etc., and the Company shall not be liable for any refund. - 3. The Company will perform refund operations in the following cases.
- (1) Refunds will be made only to the member who purchased the tickets from the Company (the person in whose name the tickets were purchased).
- (2) Refunds for event fees shall be made in accordance with the prescribed procedures to be provided to the customer's e-mail address within the refund period determined by the organizer, etc. Refunds will not be made if the refund period has passed or if the procedures are different from those described above.
- (3) In the event that we make a refund of the event fee in accordance with the preceding item, we will, in principle, also refund the various fees (excluding settlement fees) charged at the time of

purchase of the event. In principle, refunds will also be made for the various fees (excluding settlement fees) incurred at the time of event purchase. However, depending on the event, the fees may not be refundable.

(4) Under no circumstances will we pay for expenses (transportation, lodging, communication, shipping, etc.) other than the event fee and the various fees specified in the preceding paragraph. <u>Article 14</u> (Termination of Reservations and Additional Sales)

Even during the event sales period, event sales will end when the planned number of tickets has been sold. However, sales may be resumed if additional tickets are added by the organizer. <u>Article 15</u> (Prohibited Items)

- 1. You shall not engage in any of the following acts when using the Service.
- Any act that damages or infringes, or may damage or infringe upon the rights, privacy, honor, credit, etc. of the Company or any third party.
- Actions that cause or may cause disadvantage or damage to the Company or a third party
- Actions that defame or slander the Company or third parties.

- Actions for the purpose of profit, or actions for the purpose of preparing for such actions.
- Acts that use passwords in an unauthorized manner
- Acts that interfere with the smooth operation of this service or may otherwise disrupt this service.
- Actions that intentionally transmit or otherwise propagate harmful programs such as computer viruses.
- Actions that attempt to use the Service in an unusual manner, such as by making a large number of applications using software that performs automatic entry, etc.

Article 17 (Discontinuance, Suspension, Change, etc. of Service)

- 1. the Company may change, suspend, or discontinue all or part of the Service for any of the following reasons
- When performing maintenance of equipment, computer systems, networks, etc. related to the Service
- When the provision of this service becomes difficult due to natural disasters or other unavoidable reasons.
- When an emergency occurs or is likely to occur

- In the event of suspension, interruption, or modification of telecommunication services by telecommunication carriers (related to this service); or
- In any other cases where MTI deems it necessary to temporarily suspend the Service for the purpose of its operation.
- 2. In no event shall the Company be liable for any loss or damage incurred by you or any third party as a result of any change, interruption, or suspension of the Service based on the preceding paragraph.

#### Article 18 (Disclaimer)

- 1. #### **Privacy Policy**

We handle the personal information we receive from our customers in accordance with the following terms and conditions. In addition, customers who use this service shall agree to the following terms and conditions before using this service.

#### Article 1 (Acquisition of Personal Information)

- 1. the customer shall provide the Company with the customer information such as name, address, telephone number, e-mail address, payment details, etc., information on the customer's interests and preferences, event application history, and other information such as usage history of the Service (hereinafter collectively referred to as "Personal Information") for the purpose of use stipulated in Article 2 of this Agreement. <u>Article 6</u> (Procedures for Requests for Disclosure, Correction, etc. of Personal Information Subject to Disclosure)

1. if your personal information falls under the category of personal information subject to disclosure, we will respond to your request for notification of purpose of use, disclosure,

correction, addition, deletion, suspension of use, elimination, and suspension of provision to a third party, etc. after confirming your identity. However, there may be cases in which we are unable to respond to the requested information, such as when there is a significant hindrance to the proper conduct of our business.
